Dear Bowlers and Parents,

In Order to promote youth bowling Miller's Recreation is offering the incentive of a bowling ball or proshop money (to be used towards purchase of shoes, a bowling bag, etc.) to youth bowlers who attend every regular day of bowling. I realize that perfect attendance is not always a possibility due to family commitments and/or illness. So, I have made the following guidelines:

- A youth bowler will receive a bowling ball or pro-shop money (their choice) if the bowler attends all 21 weeks of regular bowling
- If a bowler misses 1 (one) week they can buy this week (\$6 for youth or \$8 for junior) to earn a ball or pro-shop money
- \* If a bowler knows ahead of time that they will be absent there are two options:
  1. Pre-bowl games for the upcoming weekend. The bowler can come in during the week before, pay the normal Sat. bowling fee and record their scores which will then count towards their team's scores for the upcoming week.
  2. Get a substitute bowler to bowl for them.
- If a bowler has a substitute for the week or pre-bowls they can still earn the ball or pro-shop money.

Weekly Bowling Fees:

Youth Shift: \$6.00 per day  
Bowl 2 games  
11:30 – 2:00

Junior Shift: \$8.00 per day  
Bowl 3 games  
2:30 – 5:00

Sanctioning:

\*Roll n' Grow Program- \$8 one time fee receive a DVD and instruction books

\*Youth & Junior League-\$15 one time fee. With this payment your child will receive a USBC (United States Bowling Congress) jersey and be eligible to earn patches and awards throughout the season.
